Code of Conduct

The American Muscle Car Club (AMCC) is committed to fostering a welcoming, inclusive, and respectful environment for all our members. Our Code of Conduct outlines the principles and guidelines every member must uphold while participating in AMCC's activities and engaging with fellow members.

By joining our community, you agree to abide by the following rules:

- **Respect:** Treat all members with respect, dignity, and courtesy, regardless of age, race, ethnicity, gender, sexual orientation, religion, socio-economic background, or car ownership status. Discrimination, harassment, or disrespectful behavior will not be tolerated. Remember that when chatting in the community, everyone is listening, so respect the community by keeping conversations relevant to everyone and private conversations private. Your respect is the cornerstone of our community, making each member feel valued and integral to our shared experience.
- **Safety:** Prioritize safety while driving and participating in AMCC activities. Follow traffic rules and regulations, drive responsibly, and respect the safety and well-being of fellow members, pedestrians, and other road users.
- **Collaboration:** Work with fellow members to create a positive, supportive, and engaging environment. Do your best to encourage each other, share experiences, and contribute to AMCC's growth and development.
- **Integrity:** Be honest and transparent when interacting with other members and AMCC's partners. Do not engage in fraud or fraudulent activities, misrepresent your identity or qualifications, or misuse AMCC resources for personal gain.
- **Compliance:** Members must abide by all AMCC's rules, regulations, and guidelines, as well as local laws and regulations. Members who violate these rules may face disciplinary action, including suspension or termination of membership.

- **Communication:** Communicate respectfully, professionally, and constructively with fellow members and AMCC’s representatives. Avoid using offensive language, personal attacks, or disruptive behavior. This includes avoiding condescending or patronizing forms of communication.
- **Privacy:** Respect the privacy of fellow members. Do not send unsolicited private messages to other members without a good explanation or discussion. Ask for permission from the members first. Do not share personal information or contact details without explicit consent. Any form of stalking, harassing another member privately or publicly, or unwanted contact is strictly prohibited.
- **No Shouting:** Please be friendly and respectful to everyone and avoid online shouting. That includes entire messages in all caps.
- **No Touting:** Do not tout any products or services. If a community member has a need, and you have a product or service that helps or solves it, please share it. But do not tout, please.
- **No Trolling:** Do not troll or make comments or remarks that insult or attack other members or otherwise deliberately set out to annoy or disrupt conversations. Any of these in any form will not be tolerated.

If you have any questions about the Code of Conduct, contact any of the Executive Board members. We have to say this in the interest of clarity: Based on the severity of the breach, any breaches may lead to suspension or termination of membership.

That said, AMCC is a place defined by mutual respect and maturity but also a safe and reasonable place. We are committed to safeguarding this community as a safe space for all. Help keep it the place you want to be. Your safety and comfort are our top priorities, and we are dedicated to maintaining a secure and reasonable environment for all.
